RE: REQUEST FOR NOMINATION OF MEMBER FOR THE NATIONAL CONSULTTIVE MEETING ON THE TRUTH, RECONCILIATION AND REPARATION COMMISSION (TRRC)

It would be recalled that the government of The Gambia had indicated its desire to establish a Truth, Reconciliation and Reparations Commission (TRRC) to investigate human rights violations and abuses committed during the former regime to foster social cohesion and encourage national reconciliation among Gambians, to address impunity and also to recognize the rights and dignity of victims through the provision of appropriate Reparations.

The establishment of the TRRC is a critical part of peace-building, reconciliation and the consolidation of democracy in the new Gambia. It is therefore important to ensure ownership of the process by the people of The Gambia through a national consultative process. The process and mechanisms must be driven and owned by Gambians.

The Government of the Gambia in collaboration with Civil Society Organisations and Independent Partners, through the stewardship of the Ministry of Justice is embarking on a nationwide consultative program with a special focus on engaging with the populace.

The program is set to commence on the 6th of August, 2017 to the 18th August 2017 as set out in the table below.
